1. Participation in this competition entails the acceptance of these regulations
2. All entries' copyright belongs to the Centre. The entries will not be returned. Please retain backup copies in advance
3. Participants must consent to and authorize the Centre to reserve the right in Hong Kong or elsewhere to publish, reproduce, modify, transmit or issue or broadcast the videos
4. Each group should produce a micro-film of 3 to 10 minutes. Animation, digitals, drama performance or the production of sound, etc can be inserted in the micro-film.
5. Entries must be original
6. The films should be submitted in digital format (MP4、WAV) and the resolution should not below 720 X 576 (4:3) or 720 X 480 (16:9)
7. Provide 3 stills (1920x1080) for promotional purposes
8. The content should not be obscene, violent, obnoxious to public morals or illegal
9. Music/ Sounds must be Original or authorized by the author
10. The participants submitting the film are responsible for clearing all rights to the content of the work relevant to the film's use at the competition. This includes the actual screenings, the industry film market and the use of excerpts on our website. By submitting, they state that screening or other use of the film in the competition does not infringe rights held by third parties (e. g. copyrights, personality or trademark rights), and that the rights to any material produced by others (music, film footage, photographs, text etc.) used in the film have been cleared. Participants should be responsible and ensure that submissions do not infringe anyone's intellectual property rights. Otherwise, participants will be disqualified and the Centre reserves the right to take any necessary legal action.
11. The decision of the Selection Committee and Jury will be final
12. The Centre reserves the rights of changing or deleting the contents of the competition. Any changes to the contents, items or provisions will be announced in the official website.
